

Traffic signs

Part 2 / Exercise 3

Do you know the most important traffic signs for cyclists in Austria?

Please mark with a cross:



- No cycles
- Bicycle track**
- Give way

This sign marks the beginning of a bicycle track, with an obligation to use. This means you are required to use the track if riding a bicycle (except racing bikes, multi-track bikes and bikes with trailers having excess width).



- No entry
- Pedestrian crossing
- Separated track for cyclists and pedestrians**

Bicycle track and a footpath proceed next to each other. Stay on the track assigned to you by the traffic sign.



- Shared track for cyclists and pedestrians**
- Pedestrian zone
- Give way

This type of bicycle track is shared with pedestrians. Please watch out and pay attention.



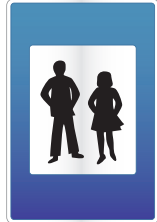
- One-way traffic
- Cyclist crossing**
- Bicycle track

Cyclists are allowed to cross the road at this point safely. Other road users are not allowed to endanger them.

- Bicycle track
- Give way
- Pedestrian zone**

In this zone motorised vehicles are prohibited. Cyclists are only allowed to ride here if an additional sign saying 'Cyclists excepted' allows it.



- Pedestrian zone
- One-way traffic
- Pedestrian crossing**

Pedestrians have right of way and must be allowed to cross the road.



- Priority road
- One-way traffic**
- Give way

You are only allowed to ride in the direction of the arrow, unless an additional sign allows cyclists to do so.



- No cycles**
- Pedestrian zone
- Bicycle track

You are not allowed to ride a bicycle here, but you are allowed to push it.



- No entry
- Stop**
- Give way

You have to completely stop here and give priority to all other road users.



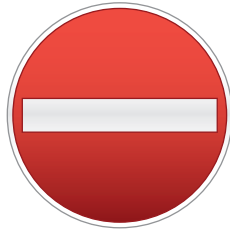
- Stop
- Priority road
- Give way**

All other road users have priority.

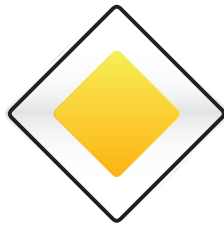
- No entry**
- Stop
- No cycles

You are not allowed to enter here, unless an additional sign allows cyclists to do so.



- Stop
- Pedestrian zone
- Closed to all vehicles (in both directions)**

In this marked area there is an absolute ban on driving any vehicle at all, except bicycles when being pushed.



- One-way traffic
- Priority road**
- Give way

This sign signals that you have right of way.
